# **Dr. Tyler Smiley**

As we step into a new year, I'm excited about the opportunities ahead for us as a church family to grow in our understanding of God's Word and deepen our relationship with Him. This year, we will embark on a journey through Scripture that will take us back to the rich foundation of the Old Testament. Our focus will be on how we see the gospel woven throughout the

lives of key figures in the Old Testament.

Often, we think of the gospel as beginning with Jesus in the New Testament, but the truth is that God's redemptive plan has been at work since the very beginning. Through the lives of people like Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and through the prophecies and promises of the Old Testament, we catch alimpses of the Messiah to come and the good news of salvation that He would bring. I can't wait to explore these stories with you and see how they lead us to worship our Savior more fully.

As we begin this journey, I want to encourage you in two key areas:


